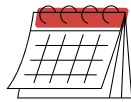

PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

We are looking for 24 participants from Greece, Ukraine, Spain and France (4 participants from each country and 10 from France)

- Young people from 18 to 30 years old
- Interest and motivation in the fight against discrimination
- Experience or future experience in youth work
- Good knowledge of English language

TOPICS AND METHODOLOGY OF THE PROJECT

The training programme 'Combating Discrimination in International Volunteering Projects' aims to strengthen facilitators' skills in intercultural facilitation, encourage the exchange of best practices among participants, and develop awareness-raising tools to combat discrimination

The methodology (non-formal education, meetings with professionals, discussions) and the structure of the project will encourage an active involvement of each participant in order to develop competences and new tools for personal and social development.

Non-formal education tools will be used to create a friendly and caring atmosphere, considering each participant in his or her diversity, personality and culture, so that each person can feel free to express him(her)self, share his or her experiences, teach and learn from the others.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT



The activities of this project will expect to lead young participants to:

- Understand international work camps as a structured educational tool.
- Understand and integrate the role and responsibilities of international work camp leaders.
- Develop skills in non-formal education methods and acquire group facilitation methods.
- Reflect on the role of a facilitator in an intercultural setting.
- Identify, understand and combat situations of discrimination when working with young people.
- Learn to manage relationships between different stakeholders (international volunteers, local population, organisation and local partners).

Participants will have the opportunity to work in small groups on practical issues relating to discrimination, conflict management.

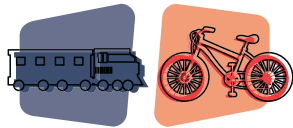


At the end of the project, participants will produce a guide in the form of a shared resource.

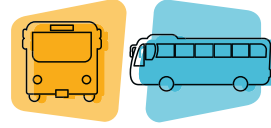
It will bring together the most relevant activities and findings from the project. This final document will serve as a useful resource for all organisations involved in the project.

TRAVEL COST



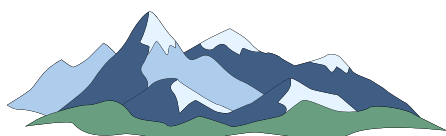
You will be reimbursed the real costs of your transport fees up to a certain limit. Your travel cost refund depends on the distance between your country and France. The outline is defined by European Union. This table indicates the maximum amount of money that is reimbursed.

SUPER BESSE



We will be hosted in the Sancy community, one of the most beautiful in the region, in **Super Besse**. It is a ski village forming part of the municipality of Besse Saint-Anastaise, medieval city.

Near Super Besse is one of the most beautiful and mysterious lakes in the region, Lake Pavin, of volcanic origin.



ACCOMODATION IN SUPER BESSE

The training will take place at the mountain chalet of Super-Besse.

Situated approximately 50 km from Clermont-Ferrand, it is located at an altitude of 1350 m.

The chalet is composed of an accommodation area, two activity rooms and a dining room. The participants will be hosted in rooms of 1, 2 or 3 persons with all supplies included. Note that there is no wifi connection in the accommodation but it is possible to use 4G with your phones !

Meal will be prepared by the staff and adapted to different diets.
